Sounds Easy...But


- No legal guidelines exist

- There are guidelines by several organizations, but none of them are legal guidelines



Four Easy Steps


1: Image Alt Text

If you do nothing else...do this!




Decorative images do NOT need alt text

- Screen readers read the alt text of an image
- Every image with purpose should have alt text



2: Easy-to-Read Content

- Font styles
- Text size
- Watch the CAPS
- Colors



3: Page Organization

Headings on pages/articles

• 67.5% of people who use screen readers use headings to navigate a web page¹

Homepage button on main navigation

4: Watch Your Extras

Video Captions

Text-only options for videos, PDFs, and Java/Flash Content

Inaccessible Flash content is in the top 5 complaints by people

with disabilities¹

No Autoplay

No flashing content



What else can you do?

85% of disabled users say better websites will help accessibility more than better technology¹

- Tab button for Navigation
- "Skip Content" code
- Form Labels


- Download a screen reader to your browser
